

Specific Award Criteria: Rehabilitation Innovation Award – Adversity into Achievement



- **Eligibility:** Open to rehabilitation professionals such as case managers, insurers, solicitors, and others working to support and provide innovative approaches for individuals with challenging rehabilitation needs.
- **Criteria:**
 - The award looks for innovations in rehabilitation or case management practices that contribute to existing models and address complex challenges.
 - Submissions need to detail the innovation, including clear evidence of the approach and its outcomes.
 - Nominees should demonstrate their initiative’s impact on the rehabilitation process and go beyond basic expectations.
 - A focus is placed on demonstrating how the approach advances the business, including financial contributions and outcomes.

Submission Guidelines:

- **Nominations:** Can be submitted by case managers, case management companies, or external providers.
- **Inclusion of CMSUK Standard 4:** Submissions must align with CMSUK Standard 4: Intervention & Evaluation.

No	Standard Title	Standard Description
4.	Intervention & Evaluation	Intervention is all the actions taken by the case manager on behalf of the service user. The process can include prioritising, planning, implementing, co-ordinating, monitoring and evaluating the options and services required to address agreed goals and promote quality cost effective outcomes. Intervention may be interpreted as the process of initiating, undertaking and co-ordinating activities with or on behalf of a service user in order to move them towards their stated goal.

- **Supporting Evidence:** Nominations should be backed with detailed supporting evidence.

Key Submission Requirements:

- **Goal setting:** The initiative should have clear goals, and these goals should have been met or exceeded.
- **Impact:** Information should be provided on how the initiative has impacted the rehabilitation/case management community.
- **Generalizability:** The potential for the initiative to be applied broadly or adapted for other contexts.
- **Testimonials:** Must include testimonials of no more than 1200 words.
- **Client Information:** Must be anonymized to ensure client privacy.
